Petitioners claim that they have attained majority and married against the wishes of their family members. Apprehending threat to their life and liberty, they have filed the present petition for protection. Petitioners claim to have submitted a representation (Annexure P-5) dated 02.12.2019 in this regard to the Superintendent of Police, Bathinda.

Notice of motion to the Advocate General, Punjab.

On asking of the Court, Mr. Jagmohan S. Ghuman, Deputy Advocate General, Punjab accepts notice on behalf of the State. Copy supplied.

Heard. The petitioners have placed on record Aadhar Cards of petitioners No.1 and 2 (Annexures P-1 and P-2) and the petitioners have also produced on record copy of their marriage certificate (Annexure P-3). Today photocopy of matriculation certificate of petitioner No.1 has been made available which is taken on record.

This petition is disposed of with a direction to the Senior Superintendent of Police, District Bathinda, Punjab, to look into the

representation (Annexure P-5) dated 02.12.2019 and ensure that no harm is caused to the petitioners.

However, it is made clear that this order shall not be treated as stamp of the Court about the marriage of the parties and no opinion in this regard regarding the validity of the marriage has been expressed.
