Today at the very outset, learned counsel for the petitioners submits that he may be permitted to withdraw the petition with liberty to raise all the points raised herein before investigating agency including his plea to the effect that a false FIR has been lodged after a delay of about 24 days and that the falsity would be evident from the fact that it is a case where the petitioner No.1 himself had already approached Civil Courts seeking dissolution of marriage vide Annexure P-1, and in these circumstances the allegations of oral '*talaak*' do not seem plausible.

In view of the aforesaid submission, the petition is dismissed as withdrawn with liberty aforesaid. Since the matter is stated to be still under investigation, the investigating agency shall consider all such pleas as may be put forth on behalf of the petitioners and to rule out false implication.
