[1] Learned counsel contends that despite the petitioner fulfilling the conditions stipulated in Instructions (Annexure P-3) dated 11.11.2003, the claim of the petitioner for regularization has not been considered, till date, despite representation (Annexure P-5) dated 01.08.2019 having been submitted.

[2] Learned counsel states that the petitioner would be satisfied, if the writ petition is disposed of by directing respondent No.2 to consider and decide the representation (Annexure P-5) dated 01.08.2019, in accordance with law in a time bound manner.

[3] Without commenting upon the merits of the claim or the entitlement of the petitioner to the relief claim, the writ petition is ***disposed of*** by directing respondent No.2 to consider and decide the representation (Annexure P-5) dated 01.08.2019, in accordance with law within 03 months from the date of receipt of certified copy of this order.
