Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that petitioner was entitled for the grant of benefit under the Assured Career Progression Scheme after completing 4, 9 and 14 years of service, which benefits was not extended to the petitioner, while he was in service though, he was fully eligible for the grant of the same.

The prayer of the petitioner is for issuance of a direction to the respondents to grant him the benefit of the Assured Career Progression Scheme alongwith consequential benefits.

Learned counsel for the petitioner states that for the relief, which has been claimed in the present writ petition, petitioner has served the respondents a legal notice dated 19.04.2019 (Annexure P-4), which is still pending consideration and the petitioner will be satisfied, at this stage,

in case a time bound direction is issued to respondent No. 2 to decide the said legal notice.

In view of the request made, without expressing any opinion on the merits of the case and the claim being made by the petitioner, respondent No. 2 is directed to decide the legal notice dated 19.04.2019 (Annexure P-4) by passing a speaking order within a period of three months from the date of receipt of a certified copy of this order.

Writ petition stands disposed of accordingly.
