Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that the petitioner is similarly situated to Shavinder Singh @ Bagar, who was admitted to bail by this Court vide an order passed on 28.11.2019 in CRM-M-48578-2019, with it being noticed that an FIR has been registered against an Inspector and a Sub-Inspector of Police, on the recommendation of the Senior Superintendent of Police, for the commission of offences punishable under the Prevention of Corruption Act, 1988, they allegedly having demanded a bribe from the mother of the petitioner, for releasing him “as an accused” in the FIR in question, i.e. FIR No. 55 dated 19.08.2019, registered at Police Station Amir Khas, District Fazilka.

That being so, whether or not the contents of the FIR as is in question presently are correct nor not, or whether money was being demanded illegally after having registered a “false case”, would be a matter to be examined by the trial Court, and consequently, without making any comment on the actual merits of this case, in the aforesaid circumstances, the petition is allowed. The petitioner shall be

admitted to bail upon his furnishing adequate bail bonds and surety bonds to the satisfaction of the learned Chief Judicial Magistrate/Duty Magistrate.
