The petitioners filed a writ petition seeking direction to the respondents to decide the representation for releasing his land by passing a speaking order. The writ petition was disposed of on 29.5.2019.

The order is reproduced below:

"Learned counsel for the petitioners states that representation submitted by the petitioners for release of land has not been decided so far.

After hearing learned counsel for the petitioners, we would, without commenting on the merits of the claim of the petitioners, deem it appropriate to dispose of the present petition with a direction to the official respondents to consider and decide the representation (Annexure P-7) by passing a speaking order thereon as expeditiously as possible. Ordered accordingly."

The present petition is filed pleading that needful is not done by the respondents.

From perusal of order of the writ Court, it is evident that no time bound directions were given. The needful was to be done as expeditiously as possible.

Considering the procedure involved for taking decision for release of the land, it would not be appropriate at this stage to initiate contempt proceedings against the respondents.

The contempt petition is disposed of. However, there is no doubt that an order as per direction of this Court would be passed by the respondents as expeditiously as possible.
