On 04.12.2019, this Court had directed the Superintendent of Police, Hisar to file specific affidavit with regard to the whereabouts of the petitioners and their status as on today.

Learned counsel for the petitioners had earlier also stated that he had no instructions from the petitioners and they could not be contacted. Today also he has stated that he has no instructions from the petitioners as they have not contacted.

Report by way of affidavit of Joginder Singh HPS, Deputy Superintendent of Police, Narnaund on behalf of respondents No.1 to 3 has been filed today in Court and the same is taken on record. It has been stated in the report that he had visited to the residence of petitioner No.2 village Bhaklana where the petitioners were found present and their statements were recorded. It is further stated in the affidavit that as per the statements of the petitioners, they have solemnized the marriage with their own sweet wishes and are living at village Bhaklana, Tehsil Bass, District Hisar and

that they do not have any kind of threat as they are living with the parents of petitioner No.2 happily. It is further stated in the affidavit that statement of petitioner No.2 was also recorded who stated that they have no objection and petitioners are residing with them. It is further stated in the affidavit that Police Inspector visited the residence of private respondents also at village Rohat, District Sonapat and recorded their statements in which private respondents stated that Nikita i.e. petitioner No.2 has solemnized the marriage with Gyaneshwar without their wishes. However, they have no objection with this marriage and that it was further stated by them that they have socially boy cotted Nikita but the petitioners will not face dire consequence on their part.

In view of the affidavit filed by the learned State counsel, nothing survives in the present petition. Therefore, the same is dismissed.
