order dated 12.10.2018 passed by learned Single Judge dismissing the writ petitions filed by the petitioners (appellants herein).

2. The appellants approached this Court by filing writ petitions challenging the award made by the Labour Court rejecting the reference on the ground that they have failed to produce any evidence of continuous employment in terms of Section 25-B of the Industrial Disputes Act, 1947 (in short the Act) and, thus, their termination cannot be said to be in violation of Section 25-F of the Act.

3. Even before the learned Single Judge, the appellants have failed to produce any such evidence or material to demonstrate that the findings recorded by the Labour Court were against the weight of evidence on record or based on misreading of any material piece of evidence. The findings recorded by the Labour Court are concluded findings of fact affirmed by the learned Single Judge and, thus, we do not find any good reason to interfere with the same in intra court appeals.

4. The appeals are devoid of merits and accordingly stand dismissed.
