Learned counsel for the petitioner states that although the mandate of the statute is that the respondents are bound to enter the mutation, the moment the sale is executed/registered by the competent authority but in any case, petitioner would move an application for sanctioning the mutation on the basis of the sale deeds dated 17.10.2006 (Annexures P-7 and P-8) with the Assistant Collector 2nd Grade, Palwal, Tehsil and District Palwal-respondent No.3 within a period of two weeks.

In case the petitioner moves such an application, the same shall be considered and decided by Assistant Collector 2nd Grade, Palwal, Tehsil and District Palwal-respondent No.3 at an early date preferably within a period of four months in case the same is not contested.

As far as the prayer of change of mutation without any notice to the petitioner is concerned, the counsel for the petitioner keeps the said prayer reserved qua the petitioner.

Prayer granted.

The writ petition stands disposed of.
