Mr. Amardeep Sheoran, Advocate has put in appearance on behalf of respondent No. 2 and has filed his Vakalatnama, which is taken on record.

Learned State counsel has submitted status report by way of affidavit of Sub Inspector Suresh Kumar, SHO, Police Station Salhawas, District Jhajjar, which is taken on record and it reveals that the petitioner along with her two daughters left the house in the company of her parents and is now residing with her parents along with one daughter. It is not disputed that one daughter namely Dimple is with the father-Deepak.

Learned counsel for the petitioner fairly states that he does not want to press the present petition if the matter is relegated to the Court of Guardians and Wards and a direction is issued to decide the same within stipulated period.

Request of the petitioner is allowed and the present petition is dismissed as withdrawn.

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The petitioner is at liberty to file a petition before the Guardians Court within one week from the date of receipt of certified copy of this order. The Guardians Court is directed to decide the same within a period of three weeks thereafter along with application for interim custody.

The petition is dismissed as withdrawn.
