The present revision petition has been preferred against the order dated 28.08.2018 dismissed the appeal filed by the petitioner against the order dated 21.08.2018 passed by learned Principal Magistrate Juvenile Justice Board, Sangrur vide which the bail application filed by the petitioner was dismissed.

Petitioner is a juvenile and is facing the proceedings before the Principal Magistrate Juvenile Justice Board, Sangrur. He kept in Observation Home Shimla Puri, Ludhiana. He has undergone actual sentence of 06 months and 09 days. Statement of the prosecutrix has already been recorded.

Keeping in view the facts and circumstances, the criminal revision petition is allowed. Consequently, order dated 21.08.2018 passed by Principal Magistrate Juvenile Justice Board, Sangrur and judgment dated

28.08.2018 passed by learned Additional Sessions Judge, Sangrur are hereby *set aside* and the petitioner is ordered to be released on bail to the satisfaction of the concerned learned Principal Magistrate Juvenile Justice Board/Duty Magistrate, subject to the condition that he shall maintain good moral character during the proceedings.
