Present petition under Section 438 of the Code of Criminal Procedure is for grant of anticipatory bail to the petitioner in case F.I.R. No.1051 dated 04.10.2018, under Sections 120-B, 406, 420 of the Indian Penal Code, registered at Police Station Chandani Bagh, District Panipat.

Vide order dated 15.12.2018 passed by this Court, the petitioner was directed to join the investigation. On 27.03.2019 also, the petitioner was directed to join the investigation again as it was contended by learned State counsel that the petitioner though has joined the investigation, but he is not cooperating with the investigating agency.

Today also, learned State counsel, on instructions from ASI Dilbag Singh, contended that though the petitioner has joined the investigation, but he is not cooperating with the investigating agency and the alleged recovery of articles, which were entrusted to the petitioner as trust property of the complainant, were not got recovered, for which custodial interrogation of the petitioner is necessary.

In view of the above, no case is made out for grant of anticipatory bail to the petitioner and the present petition stands dismissed.
