ANUPINDER SINGH GREWAL, J. (ORAL)

The petitioners are seeking anticipatory bail in FIR No.234 dated 11.11.2018, under Sections 452, 326, 324, 323, 506, 148 and 149 IPC, registered at Police Station City Gurdaspur, District Gurdaspur.

Learned counsel for the petitioners contends that allegation against petitioner No.1 and petitioner No.2 are that they had given dang and bat blow respectively on the shoulders of the complainant. He also contends that the matter has been compromised and a petition for quashing of FIR on the basis of compromise is being filed.

A coordinate Bench of this Court, by the order dated 03.12.2018, had directed the petitioners to appear before the Investigating Officer and join the investigation and in the event of their arrest, they were to be released on ad-interim bail to the satisfaction of the Arresting Officer, subject to the conditions

envisaged under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.

Learned State counsel, on instructions from SI Dharamjeet Singh, Police Station City Gurdaspur states that the petitioners have joined investigation and are not required for custodial interrogation.

In view of the submissions of learned counsel for the petitioners and keeping in view the fact that the petitioners have joined investigation, the order dated 03.12.2018 granting interim bail to the petitioners is made absolute.

However, the petitioners shall abide by the conditions stipulated under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C. They shall also join investigation as and when called upon to do so.

The petition stands disposed of.
