The present petition has been filed by the petitioner under Section 439 Cr.P.C for grant of bail pending trial in case FIR No.213 dated 20.03.2019 registered under Sections 148, 149, 323, 325, 307 & 506 IPC (Section 3 of the SC/ST (Prevention of Atrocities) Act, 1989 at Police Station Assandh, District Karnal.

It is contended by counsel for the petitioner that the name of the petitioner has been wrongly involved in this case. Even as per the case of the prosecution, no injury is attributed to the petitioner. Still further, it is submitted that, by any means, the petitioner is not connected with the offences punishable under Sections 307 & 325 IPC. The petitioner is in custody since 04.09.2019. The investigation of the case is complete. Therefore, the petitioner is not required for any investigation purposes. Hence, the petitioner deserves to be released on bail pending trial.

On the other hand, learned counsel for the State, on instructions from ASI Harbhajan Singh, submits that the petitioner was member of the group, which caused injury. However, it is not disputed that no specific injury is attributed to the petitioner, as such. It is also not disputed that the petitioner is in custody since 04.09.2019 and that the challan has already been filed in this case.

In view of the above, but without commenting upon merits of the case, the present petition is allowed. It is ordered that the petitioner be released on bail on his furnishing bail bonds/sureties to the satisfaction of the trial Court/Duty Magistrate.
