The petitioner has filed the present petition under Article 226/227 of the Constitution of India for issuance of a writ in the nature of habeas Corpus for release of detenue-Anju from illegal custody of respondents No.4 and 5.

Vide order dated 06.12.2019 passed by this Court, while issuing notice of motion, respondent No.3-SHO, Police Station Sadar, District Jind was directed to ensure appearance of detenue-Anju before this Court.

Respondent No.3-SHO, Police Station Sadar, District Jind has ensured appearance of detenue-Anju before this Court from Protection Home, Jind.

Deteune-Anju has stated that she had performed marriage with respondent No.4-Sanjay and is living with him out of her own will and she has not been illegally detained by respondents No.4 and 5 or

any other person. She wants to continue to live with respondent No.4-Sanjay out of her own free will and now she does not want to continue to live in the Protection Home.

Since detenue-Anju has not been illegally detained by respondent No.4 and 5 or any other person and she wants to live with her husband respondent No.4-Sanjay out of her own free will and does not want to continue to live in the Protection Home, Jind, she is allowed to go with respondent No.4-Sanjay.

No further proceedings are required to be taken in the present habeas corpus petition which is disposed of accordingly.
