Petitioner has filed this petition under Section 439 of Cr.P.C. for grant of regular bail in case FIR No.58 dated 27.03.2019 registered under Sections 302, 404, 411, 201, 34 of the Indian Penal Code at Police Station Tripuri, Patiala, District Patiala.

Learned counsel for the petitioner states that no role has been attributed to the petitioner in the present FIR. Moreover, as per the recovery memo, one gold ring of the deceased was recovered from the petitioner whereas, as per the postmortem report, the gold ring was found on the body of the deceased. Petitioner is in custody since 30.3.2019.

This fact has not been disputed by learned counsel appearing for the State and he further brought to the notice of this court that out of 28 witnesses, only two witnesses have been examined. The trial would take time to conclude.

In view of the above, without commenting anything on the merits, lest it should prejudice the case of either side, the petition is allowed and the petitioner is ordered to be released on regular bail to the satisfaction of the learned trial Court/Duty Magistrate concerned.
