Prayer in the present petition is for grant of anticipatory bail to the petitioner in case FIR No.39, dated 13.03.2017 under Sections 148, 149, 323, 325, 341, 427, 506 of IPC and Section 3 of the SC/ST Act, 1989, registered at Police Station Shahzadpur, District Ambala.

Vide order dated 10.12.2018, the petitioner was granted interim protection and was directed to join the investigation before the Investigating Officer.

However, subsequently, it was pointed out by the counsel for the petitioner that challan had already been filed before the trial Court and that the petitioner would be required to be present before the trial Court instead of being present before the Investigating Officer. Accordingly, vide order dated 18.12.2018, the earlier order dated 10.12.2018 was modified and the petitioner was directed to appear before the trial Court, with a further direction that in case, the petitioner so appears before the trial Court, then the trial Court shall grant interim bail to him on his furnishing bail/sureties bonds to the satisfaction of the trial Court.

Today, learned counsel for the petitioner has produced the order dated 19.12.2018 which shows that the petitioner has already appeared before the trial Court and he is facing the proceedings.

Learned State counsel, on instructions from ASI Rajpal has also submitted that in fact, even the charge has been framed in this case and the case is now fixed for recording of the prosecution evidence.

In view of the above, the interim order dated 18.12.2018, passed by this Court, is made absolute.
