Petitioner-Jagpreet Singh has filed the present petition under Section 438 Cr.P.C. for grant of anticipatory bail in case FIR No. 150 dated 28.8.2019, under Sections 22, 29, 61 of NDPS Act, 1985 and Section 61 (Notification No.1) of Punjab Excise Act, 1914, registered at Police Station Sadar Kapurthala, District Kapurthala.

During the course of hearing, it is not disputed that the petitioner was the owner of the alleged vehicle, wherefrom alleged contraband was recovered. He fairly states that the petitioner is involved in other cases of similar nature as well.

Considering the nature of the offence, this Court does not find any reason to extend the extraordinary concession of pre-arrest bail to the

petitioner.

Resultantly, the petition is dismissed.
