Learned counsel for the petitioner at the initial stage when the case was taken up today submitted that the information which has been supplied to him appears to be self contradictory. In this regard, the position was explained by the counsel for the State on instructions from Sh.Rajesh Kumar, Principal, Government Senior Secondary School, Jaurasi, Panipat (Haryana). He has filed an affidavit dated 12.12.2019 in Court today which is taken on record wherein the position as per record has been clarified. Learned counsel for the petitioner states that on point Nos.2 to 4, the information has not been supplied by asserting that the same is not available as per records. If that be so, the provision under the Right to Information Act clearly mentions that the information available in the office of the authority would be supplied and if the said information is not available, the same obviously cannot be supplied to the applicant. Petitioner if, still not satisfied, may avail of his remedy in accordance with law.

The writ petition stands disposed of.
