This petition has been filed by the petitioners alleging that the respondent authority has wrongly identified Shri Tirth at Village Kassan in place of the correct location of Shri Tirth, Kasan, Village Mator, Tehsil Kalayat, District Kaithal and are going ahead with the process of undertaking construction work for Ghat and Toilet, etc. under the scheme for development of religious sites and areas.

Learned counsel appearing for the petitioners submits that the authorities have wrongly notified Village Kassan as the location of Shri Tirth instead of Shri Tirth, Kasan, at Village Mator, Tehsil Kalayat, District Kaithal. It is submitted that the petitioners have filed a representation before the authorities, but the same is not being considered.

Learned Additional Advocate General, Haryana, appearing for the State-respondents, on advance copy, submits that the representation filed by the petitioners shall be considered and decided in accordance with law.

In view of the statement made by learned Additional Advocate General, Haryana, the petition filed by the petitioners is disposed of with a direction to the effect that in case the petitioners approach the respondent authority along with a copy of the order passed today and a copy of the petition, the concerned authority shall consider and decide the representation filed by the petitioners in accordance with law before proceeding further in the matter.

It is made clear that this Court has not expressed any opinion on the merits of the case.
