ANIL KSHETARPAL, J.

Petitioner prays for bail pending trial in FIR No.666 dated 01.11.2018 registered under Sections 302/323/325/307/506 of the Indian Penal Code at Police Station, Sector-58, Faridabad.

As per the case of the prosecution, the petitioner and the deceased Sanjay were working on a commercial vehicle as driver and conductor and due to a fist blow inflicted by the petitioner on Sanjay, he fell down and started bleeding from his ear and head. It is alleged that petitioner-Manjit was threatening Sanjay. As per the post-mortem report, only injury is on the head of the deceased Sanjay. The first informant, who has appeared as PW-3, has not supported the case of the prosecution. The petitioner is in custody since 03.11.2018. Till now, 3 prosecution witnesses have been examined out of total 25 prosecution witnesses proposed to be examined.

Without commenting on the merits of the case and keeping in view the aforesaid facts as also the fact that conclusion of the trial is likely to take time, it is considered appropriate to release the petitioner on regular bail on his furnishing bail bonds/surety bonds to the satisfaction of the concerned trial Court/Duty Magistrate.
