Petitioner prays for bail pending trial in FIR No.68 dated 03.11.2019 registered under Sections 419/420 of the Indian Penal Code and under Section 15 of the Indian Medical Council Act, 1956 at Police Station, Arif Ke, District Ferozepur.

As per the case of the prosecution, the petitioner was practising as a doctor without having requisite qualification. He is also not a registered medical practitioner. On search, the petitioner was found running a clinic in the village. The petitioner is in custody since 03.11.2019. The case is triable by the Magistrate.

Without commenting on the merits of the case and keeping in view the aforesaid facts as also the fact that conclusion of the trial is likely to take time, it is considered appropriate to release the petitioner on regular bail on his furnishing bail bonds/surety bonds to the satisfaction of the concerned trial Court/Duty Magistrate.
