The petitioners Amit alias Sonu and Sangeeta have been declared as proclaimed offenders vide orders dated 13.11.2018 in case bearing FIR No.150 dated 05.06.2017 under Sections 323, 354, 506, 34, 147, 149 and 120-B IPC read with Section 8 of the Protection of Children from Sexual Offences Act, 2012 pertaining to Police Station Sector 36, Chandigarh.

Since the petitioners are evading their appearance before a Court of law and as such are not entitled to any relief from a Court, much less by way of anticipatory bail under Section 438 Cr.P.C. Reliance placed on '**Lavesh v. State (NCT of Delhi) 2012(4) RCR(Criminal) 240**'. The petition on the face of it is not maintainable and stands dismissed.
