This criminal writ petition has been filed by the petitioners for issuance of writ of mandamus to the respondents No.1 to 3 to protect their life and liberty who are apprehending threat at the hands of respondent No.4-daughter-in-law of the petitioners.

Learned counsel contends that the petitioners are old aged parents-in-law of respondent No.4 who are being harassed by her. It has been further contended that the son of the petitioners passed away on 18.3.2018 and since then respondent No.4 is troubling them on one pretext or the other.

A perusal of the case file shows that respondent No.4 is widowed daughter-in-law of the petitioners, and she is residing in same accommodation. It is not the case of the petitioners that they anticipate any threat to their life. Even the representation (Annexure P-8), addressed to the Deputy Commissioner, Pathankot, annexed in support of petition is undated. The allegations contained in the petition are general in nature which reflect

domestic dispute between the parties.

Resultantly, no ground is made out to invoke the extra-ordinary jurisdiction of this Court.

Petition is dismissed.
