**FATEH DEEP SINGH, J. (ORAL)**

This order shall dispose off first anticipatory bail application filed under Section 438 Cr.P.C. by petitioners namely Simranjeet Singh and Gurinder Kaur in case bearing FIR No.107 dated 13.12.2016 registered at Police Station Nayagaon, District SAS Nagar initially under Sections 498-A, 323, 294, 34, 406 IPC whereas subsequently offences under Sections 465, 467, 468 and 120-B IPC were also added.

Learned counsel for the petitioners Mrs.Baljit Mann, Advocate submits that in compliance of the orders of interim bail dated 27.06.2018 and 14.12.2018 passed by this Court, the petitioners have joined investigations which is not controverted by learned State counsel on instructions from SI Sumit, Police Station Nayagaon, District SAS Nagar who submits that the petitioners are no longer required for further

investigation and nothing is to be recovered from them and that he has no objection if the interim order is made absolute.

Though on behalf of the complainant, Mr. Abnash Singh Bakshi, has sought to oppose grant of relief, however, in the light of the stand of the State and the fact that it would be a travesty of justice in such a situation to send the petitioners behind bars, the interim bail granted to the petitioners for initial offences as well as subsequently added offences vide orders dated 27.06.2018 and 14.12.2018 is made absolute on the same terms and conditions. The petitioners shall however abide by the conditions specified under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C. till submission of report under Section 173 Cr.P.C. (challan). Thereafter, they will be permitted to furnish regular bail bonds to the satisfaction of the trial Court.

The petition stands disposed off accordingly.
