AVNEESH JHINGAN, J. (Oral)

The present contempt petition has been filed alleging wilful disobedience of the order dated 5.5.2017 passed by this Court in CWP No. 9614 of 2017. The operative part of the said order is reproduced below:

“In these circumstances, without issuing notice to the respondents, the present petition is disposed of with a direction to respondent Nos. 1 and 2 to consider the representation of the petitioner dated 10.3.2017 (Annexure P-5) and decide the same within two months from the date of receipt of certified copy of this order by passing a speaking order.”

Replies on behalf of respondents No. 2 and 3 filed in court today are taken on record. Copies thereof have been given to learned

counsel for the petitioner.

Along with the replies, order and the pension payment order have been annexed.

In view of the replies filed, no cause of action survives in the present contempt petition. However, learned counsel for the petitioner seeks liberty to avail remedy available in accordance with law for redressal of the grievance, if any.

Dismissed as having been rendered infructuous with liberty as prayed for.

Rule is discharged.
