Through the instant petition, the petitioners seek anticipatory bail in FIR No.16 dated 12.02.2019, registered at Police Station Khanauri, District Sangrur, under Section 302 of the Indian Penal Code.

Learned counsel for the petitioners states that the petitioners have been summoned under Section 319 Cr.P.C. Earlier an enquiry was conducted by DSP, Munak, in which, the petitioners along with Biro Devi were found innocent. Learned counsel for the petitioners further states that since the petitioners are summoned under Section 319 Cr.P.C., they are ready to face the trial as similarly situated co-accused Biro Devi has been granted anticipatory bail vide order dated 30.10.2019.

In view of the above facts, but without commenting anything on the merits of the case, this petition is disposed of with a direction to the petitioners to surrender before the trial Court within a period of 10 days

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from today and on their doing so, the trial Court shall release them on bail subject to their furnishing bail/surety bonds to its satisfaction.

However, it is made clear that if the petitioners fail to surrender before the trial Court within the stipulated period, then this petition shall be treated as dismissed.
