Prayer in this petition under Section 482 Cr.P.C. is for issuance of direction to official respondents to investigate complaints dated 22.09.2018 (P/1 colly) and 28.09.2018 (P-2 colly), take legal action and lodge FIR against respondent No.5 as per law.

Heard.

Instant petition is blackmailing device of petitioner to put undue pressure on the in-laws of his son on account of matrimonial discord between his son and daughter-in-law, who is none-else, but daughter of respondent No.5.

Any complaint moved by the petitioner before the police against respondent No.5 and his family members can safely be termed as frivolous, being a counter blast to the matrimonial discord between

his son and daughter of respondent No.5. Even otherwise, petitioner has no locus standi to file any complaint against respondent No.5.

No merits. Dismissed.
