The petitioner filed a writ petition seeking direction to the respondent to regularize the service of petitioner w.e.f. 22.11.2003/19.11.2003 as her juniors have been regularized. Further the prayer was for release of consequential benefits.

The petition was disposed of on 9.9.2019 directing respondents No. 2 and 3 (in the writ petition) to consider the legal notice dated 5.7.2019. The needful was to be done within two months from the date of receipt of certified copy of order.

The present petition is filed pleading wilful disobedience of directions of this Court.
