The present writ petition has been filed seeking restoration of Ad-hoc Relief, which was granted to the petitioners by the Government of Haryana.

In support of the claim, the petitioners are relying upon the judgment of this Court passed in CWP No.4518 of 2000, dated 11.08.2003 (Annexure P-4) and judgment of Hon'ble the Supreme Court passed in Civil Appeal No.8661 of 2009, dated 08.12.2015 (Annexure P-5).

For the relief, which has been claimed in the present writ petition, the petitioners have served the respondents with a legal notice dated 14.03.2019 (Annexure P-7), which is still pending consideration with the respondents and the petitioners will be satisfied, at this stage, in case a time bound direction is issued to the

respondents to decide the said legal notice by passing an appropriate speaking order.

Without commenting upon the merits of the case or about the entitlement of the petitioners for the relief which has been claimed by them in the legal notice dated 14.03.2019 (Annexure P-7), the present writ petition is disposed of with a direction to the respondents to decide the legal notice dated 14.03.2019 (Annexure P-7), within a period of three months from the receipt of certified copy of this order.
