Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that the petitioner has made various representations i.e. Annexures P-4, P-5 and P-6, but on account of connivance of respondent No.3 with the private respondents, the interest of the petitioner is being jeopardize. The petitioner has filed a civil suit against the private respondents, in which, interim orders have been passed in his favour, yet they are out to illegally dispossess the petitioner in connivance with respondent No.3. The petitioner also fears for his life and liberty and a detailed representation dated 28.11.2019 (Annexure P-9) has been submitted before respondent No.2, but to no avail.

Notice of motion.

Mr. A.S. Gill, Sr. DAG, Punjab accepts notice on behalf of respondent Nos.1 and 2. Let three copies of the petition be supplied to him during the course of the day.

In view of the nature of the order being passed, there is no necessity to call upon respondent Nos.3 to 11, at this stage.

The petition is disposed of with direction to respondent No.2 to objectively consider the representation 28.11.2019 (Annexure P-9) and to provide necessary protection to the petitioner, in accordance with law, in case it is felt necessary. He shall also looked into the allegations of illegal trespass by the private respondents as well as allegations of connivance against respondent No.3.

Since, civil proceedings are already pending between the parties, the petitioner has a right to get the necessary relief from civil Court.
