Prayer in this petition filed under Section 438 Cr.P.C. is for grant of anticipatory bail to the petitioner in case FIR No.343 dated 11.12.2013 registered under Sections 363/366-A/120-B of IPC (Section 376 IPC and Section 4 of POCSO Act, 2012 added lateron) at Police Station City Tarn Taran, District Tarn Taran.

At this stage, learned State counsel, on instructions from ASI Jagbans Singh, states that in the aforesaid FIR, police has prepared the cancellation report and the same is pending approval of the competent authority.

Power of attorney filed on behalf of respondent No.2 in Court today, is taken on record. He states that the complainant has given an affidavit stating that she does not intend to pursue the FIR.

In view of the aforesaid development, present petition is rendered infructuous and is dismissed as such.

However, in case, the cancellation report is not accepted or is not presented on the ground that the same is not approved by the competent authority, the respondent shall give an advance notice of a week to the petitioner and the petitioner shall be entitled to file a fresh petition for grant of anticipatory bail.
