This is a petition for quashing of the FIR No. 12 dated 9.2.2012, under Sections 323, 341, 427, 506, 148 and 149 of the Indian Penal Code, registered at Police Station Sadar Rupnagar (Annexure P-1) along with all consequential proceedings arising therefrom on the basis of compromise (Annexure P-2).

Vide order dated 15.12.2018, both the parties were directed to get their statements recorded before the trial Court and learned Magistrate was directed to submit its report.

Learned Chief Judicial Magistrate, Rupnagar, vide its letter dated 15.1.2019 has reported that statement of both the parties have been recorded that they have arrived at compromise with their free volition, without any inducement, threat, promise, coercion or undue influence.

Since the matter has been compromised and the trial of the case will be useless exercise, FIR No. 12 dated 9.2.2012, under Sections 323, 341, 427, 506, 148 and 149 of the Indian Penal Code, registered at Police Station Sadar Rupnagar (Annexure P-1) along with consequential proceedings qua petitioner stands quashed.

Petition stands allowed.
