By this petition, the petitioner seeks the benefit of parole, upon him having been convicted by the trial Court for the commission of offences punishable under Sections 304-A and 279 of the IPC, and with him having been sentenced to one years' rigorous imprisonment for the former offence and six months for the latter offence.

Learned counsel submits that despite an application made for that purpose before the jail authorities, no order has been passed and that his sisters' son is to get married on 11.12.2019, as per a copy of the wedding card that has been annexed as Annexure P-1.

Notice of motion.

On the asking of the Court, Mr. Navdeep Singh, A.A.G., Haryana, accepts notice on behalf of the respondents.

Requisite number of copies of the petition be handed over to him during the course of the day.

Looking at the nature of the offence committed, this petition is disposed of with a direction to the Superintendent of Police, Kurukshetra, to have the factum of the wedding actually taking place determined from the address given in the wedding card (which is of course of Ludhiana, Punjab), and if it is found that the wedding of the petitioners' sister is taking place, he would be released on parole for a period of three days from 10.12.2019 to 13.12.2019, with him to surrender before the jail authorities on 13.12.2019.
