The petitioner has filed this petition under Section 438 Cr.P.C. for grant of anticipatory bail in FIR No.8, dated 23.05.2018, under Section 420 IPC, registered at Police Station City Zara, District Ferozepur.

Counsel for the petitioner states that false allegations have been leveled against the petitioner.

Heard.

The Court below, while dismissing the bail application, has specifically mentioned that a compromise was effected on 23.02.2017 and the petitioner had given a cheque of Rs.5,00,000/- to the complainant but the said cheque is dishonoured. Even the visa, which is alleged to have been granted through the petitioner is a fake visa.

In the light of the specific allegations made against the petitioner and keeping in view the fact that the cheque given by the petitioner is dishonoured, no interference is called for by this Court. The present petition for grant of anticipatory bail to the petitioner is, therefore, dismissed.
