The petitioner has approached this Court under Articles 226/227 of the Constitution of India read with Section 4 sub-Section (1) and Section 6 of the Haryana Good Conduct Prisoners (Temporary Release) Act, 1988, seeking directions to the respondents to grant furlough to the petitioner for a period of three weeks to enable him to meet his family members.

It is contended that the petitioner has earlier availed parole thrice. The present application moved by the petitioner is not being decided by respondent No.2. Learned counsel appearing on behalf of the petitioner states that at this stage he will be satisfied, in case directions are issued to respondent No.2-Commissioner, Faridabad Division, to decide the application dated 22.10.2019 (Annexure P-1) as per law, expeditiously.

Without adverting to the merits of the instant case, the present petition is disposed of with a direction to respondent No.2- Commissioner, Faridabad Division, to take a final view in the matter in accordance with law and decide the case of the petitioner expeditiously, preferably, within a period of three weeks from the date of receipt of certified copy of the judgment. However, in case the competent authority feels that the relief claimed by the petitioner is not admissible or made out, in that case, a speaking order be passed in the matter.
