Petitioner prays for grant of regular bail pending trial in a criminal case arising from FIR No.142 dated 04.07.2017 registered under Sections 148, 149, 323, 324, 326, 307, 506 of the Indian Penal Code at Police Station Sadar Yamuna Nagar, District Yamuna Nagar.

As per case of the prosecution, Sohita-victim was inflicted injuries by the petitioner and the other co-accused.

Learned counsel for the State, on instructions from HC Sunil Kumar, has submitted that the trial against 3 accused persons has resulted in their acquittal as all the prosecution witnesses turned hostile. He further admits that there is some sort of settlement between the parties, of course out of Court.

The petitioner has earlier filed an application for grant of pre-arrest bail in which direction was issued to the petitioner to join investigation and the recovery of alleged knife has already been made from the petitioner.

Thereafter, prayer for grant of pre-arrest bail to the petitioner was declined, resulting in his arrest. The police did not seek police remand, therefore, he is in judicial custody.

Keeping in view the facts of the case and without commenting on merits of the case, the petitioner is directed to be released on bail on his furnishing bail bonds/surety bonds to the satisfaction of the concerned trial Court/Duty Magistrate.

Accordingly, the present petition is allowed.
