Prayer in this petition filed under Section 482 Cr.PC is for issuance of a direction to respondents No.1 to 3 to hand over the investigation of FIR No.8 dated 06.02.2018 under Section 376-D IPC registered at Police Station Dharamgarh, District Sangrur to the Crime Branch, Punjab or any other independent agency.

Prayer has also been made for protection of life and liberty of the petitioner and her children at the hands of private respondents No.4 and 5 and their companions.

Power of attorney filed on behalf of respondents No.4 and 5 in Court, is taken on record.

Status report by way of affidavit of Yogesh Kumar, PPS, DSP, Sub Division Dirba has already been placed on record on behalf of respondents No.1 to 3. As per the status report, police has already prepared a cancellation report and the same is being submitted before the Court of Illaqa Magistrate after approval from the Senior Superintendent of Police, Sangrur on 07.07.2017.

Learned State counsel, on instructions from ASI Raj Singh, submits that in the aforementioned FIR, after completion of investigation, cancellation report was prepared and presented in the Court, which is pending consideration.

In view of the above, no further order is required to be passed in the present petition. However, in case the petitioner is aggrieved with the cancellation report, she is at liberty to avail an appropriate remedy, as available under law.

The present petition is, accordingly, disposed of.
