Petitioners Gian Singh, Nirpal Singh and Sohan Singh have
filed this petition under Section 438 Cr.P.C. for grant of anticipatory bail in
complaint case No.11, Instituted on 03.09.2015, COMI/000179/205, CNR
No.PBLDB-00077-2015, under Sections 323, 324, 294, 506, 148 and 149 of
the Indian Penal Code and Section 3 of the S.C./S.T. (Prevention of
Atrocities) Act, 1989.

Notice of motion was issued.

Learned State counsel and counsel for respondent No.2 have
appeared on behalf of the respondent-State and contested this petition.

I have heard learned counsel for the parties as well as learned State counsel and have gone through the record.

As per the learned counsel for the petitioners, regarding the same occurrence, the FIR has already been registered against the complainant and others and after about one year as a counter blast, this complaint was filed by the complainant.

In compliance of order dated 29.11.2018, the petitioners have already appeared before the trial Court and have been released on interim bail. No useful purpose would be served by sending them to custody.

Keeping in view the facts and circumstances of the present case; without discussing the facts of the case in minute details and without expressing any opinion on the merits of the case, I find merit in this petition and the same is allowed. The order dated 29.11.2018, granting interim bail to the petitioners, is made absolute.
