Affidavit of Mr. Raj Kumar, Collector Land Acquisition,
Drainage Circle, Patiala has been filed in Court today.

The same is taken on record.

It has been averred in the said affidavit that sanction has been
accorded to acquire the land in question by mutual consent as per policy of
the State Government and an amount of ₹ 79,57,511/- has been returned to
the Executive Engineer, Drainage Construction Division, Sangrur vide bank
draft No.684795 dated 10.5.2019 for payment to claimant as per Annexure
R/1, after conveyance deed is executed in favour of the State Government.
It is further pointed out by counsel for the State that due to general election
the conveyance deed could not be executed in favour of the State.

Counsel for the State on instructions from Mr. Kuljit Singh,
Land Acquisition Collector, Drainage Circle, Patiala-cum-Executive
Engineer, Drainage Construction Division, Sangrur further submits that
needful will be done within four weeks from today and the necessary

amount will be credited in the account of the petitioners/land owners.
