Prayer in the writ petition is for the issuance of a writ of Mandamus for directing the respondents to allow/adjust the petitioner on the post of Assistant Professor/Extension Lecturer in the subject of Statistics on the ground that in Statistics Department in respondent No.3-College there is requirement of 4 Lecturer/Assistant Professor to teach the subject of Statistics whereas the same is being met by the respondent-College through ineligible candidates (i.e. respondent Nos.4 and 5).

2. Learned counsel contends that despite the petitioner having submitted representation Annexure P-10 dated 03.10.2019 in respect of the grievances which are the subject matter of the writ petition, no decision has been taken in respect thereto till date and that in the circumstances, the petitioners would be satisfied, if the writ petition is disposed of, at this stage, by directing respondent No.3 to consider and decide the representation Annexure P-10 dated 03.10.2019 in accordance with law in a time bound manner.

3. Without commenting on the merits of the case or the entitlement of the petitioner to the relief claimed, the writ petition is disposed of by directing respondent No.3 to consider and decide the representation Annexure P-10 dated 03.10.2019 in accordance with law after taking into account all aspects of the matter within one month from the date of receipt of certified copy of this order.
