Present petition has been filed under Section 438 of the Code of Criminal Procedure (for short 'Cr.P.C') for grant of pre arrest bail to the petitioner in case FIR No.291 dated 27.07.2018, under Section 21(b) 61/85 of the Narcotic Drugs and Psychotropic Substances Act, 1985, registered at Police Station Sadar Fatehabad.

While issuing notice of motion, this court passed the following order on 20.12.2018 :-

“Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that earlier the petitioner was released on regular bail and was appearing before the trial Court on each and every date. The petitioner could not appear only on one date i.e. 21.11.2018 as his flight was late. There was no intention on the part of the petitioner to remain absent. The petitioner undertakes to appear before the trial Court on each and every date and is ready to abide by all terms and conditions to be imposed by this Court or by the trial Court.

Notice of motion for 18.02.2019.

Meanwhile, the petitioner is directed to surrender before the trial Court on the next date of hearing i.e. 21.12.2018 and in case, he surrenders before the trial Court, he shall be released on interim bail on his furnishing bail/surety bonds to the satisfaction

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of the trial Court. ”

Learned State Counsel, on instructions from SI Jugal has acknowledged that in terms of the previous order the petitioner has joined the proceedings before the learned trial Court and is regularly appearing.

In view of above, the interim order dated 20.12.2018 is made absolute, subject to the conditions as envisaged under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C. and the present petition stands disposed off.

However, it is made clear that petitioner shall continue fully cooperating with the proceedings before the learned trial Court and shall not commit any default in appearance.
