The present petition has been filed for quashing of FIR No.54, dated 25.05.2018, registered under Sections 307, 452, 506, 34 IPC and Section 25/27 of Arms Act, 1959, at Police Station Fattu Dyinga, District Kapurthala (P-1) on the basis of compromise.

Pursuant to order dated 17.01.2019, report dated 07.02.2019 has been received from Sub Divisional Judicial Magistrate, Sultanpur Lodhi, according to which, the statements of the parties have been recorded and the compromise is genuine and has been arrived at between them without any pressure or coercion.
