This is the second petition for grant of anticipatory bail in FIR No.58 dated 13.07.2015 under Sections 399 & 402 IPC, registered at Police Station Begowal, District Kapurthala.

The operative part of the order dated 07.01.2019, vide which, the petitioner was granted interim bail, is reproduced below:

“Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that on account of noting the wrong date, the petitioner could not appear before the trial Court and his bail/surety bonds were forfeited and non-bailable warrants have been issued. It is further submitted that the petitioner will appear before the trial Court and apply for fresh bail. Notice of motion for 28.03.2019. In the meantime, petitioner is directed to surrender before the trial Court within a period of 10 days from today and the trial Court will release him on interim bail subject to his furnishing fresh bail/surety bonds and on payment of costs of Rs.20,000/- to be deposited with the District Legal Services Authority concerned.”

Today, there is no representation on behalf of the petitioner.

Learned counsel for the State, on instructions from ASI Balkar Singh, submits that petitioner has not appeared before the Investigating Officer for joining investigation in compliance with the order dated 07.01.2019.

Considering the fact that petitioner has not joined the investigation despite having been granted interim bail, the present petition is hereby dismissed.
