By way of instant petition, the petitioner has sought issuance of a writ in the nature of mandamus directing the respondents to regularize her services by seeking parity with respondents No.5 and 6 who were appointed in the year 2011. Further directions have been sought for granting benefits of pay and other applicable allowances and stepping up of her pay w.e.f 06.04.2014 which is her deemed date of regularization. The petitioner also caused Legal Notice dated 05.11.2019 (Annexure P-14) but the same has not been adverted to till date by the respondents. Hence, the writ petition.

2. Notice of motion.

3. On advance service of copy of petition, Mr. P. S. Bajwa, Additional Advocate General, Punjab has put in appearance on behalf of respondent-State.

4. Given the nature of order being passed, there is no necessity to seek return by any of the respondents as no further proceedings and/or pleadings are required.

5. Without commenting on the merits of the case, the writ petition is disposed of with a direction to respondents to objectively consider the Legal Notice dated 05.11.2019 (Annexure P-14) and also by keeping in view the contentions stated in the present writ petition by treating it as a supplementary representation and pass a speaking order, in accordance with law.

6. Let the needful be done within a period of three months from the date of receipt of certified copy of this order.

7. Disposed of in above terms.
