Prayer in the instant petition filed under Articles 226/227 of the Constitution of India is for issuance of a writ of Mandamus directing the respondents to release the contract amount of ₹78,71,128/-.

Heard.

Reply on behalf of the respondents filed in the Court, is taken on record. As per the reply, out of the total outstanding amount, a sum of ₹72,39,427/- through two separate cheques bearing Nos.019022 dated 14.12.2018 for ₹44,47,427/- and 019027 dated 14.02.2019 for a sum of ₹27,92,000/-, has already been paid to the petitioner. Learned State counsel further makes a statement at Bar that the remaining amount of ₹6,31,701/- will also be paid within three weeks from today.

In view of the above, the instant petition is dismissed as having

been rendered infructuous.

At this stage, learned counsel appearing on behalf of the petitioner states that no interest has been granted on the delayed payment.

As the principal relief has already be allowed, the petitioner is free to move representation for his prayer with regard to interest, if so advised.
