**FATEH DEEP SINGH, J. (ORAL)**

Report dated 18.03.2019 of learned Judicial Magistrate 1<sup>st</sup> Class, Amritsar has been received whereby after recording statements of complainant Rupinder Kaur and the accused persons, namely, Mandeep Singh and Joginder Kaur, the Court has shown its satisfaction that the compromise has been arrived at voluntarily, out of free will of the parties, without any undue influence, coercion or pressure.

Learned counsel for the complainant/respondent No.2 Mr.Umesh Aggarwal, Advocate on instructions from his client as well as the petitioners, who are present in Court, have made statement that the parties had given final effect to their agreement settlement/compromise

(Annexure P2) and that nothing is due towards anyone on account of this settlement and that the final effect be given to this petition.

Heard.

In the light of the satisfaction shown by the Court and the fact that the dispute between the parties being a pure matrimonial and the offences for which the accused have been hauled up are not of serious nature, together with the fact that compromise will go a long way in ironing out differences for betterment of future life of the parties and in view of the law laid down in '**Gian Singh v. State of Punjab and another**' 2012(4) RCR (Criminal) 543 and '**Kulwinder Singh and others v. State of Punjab and another**' 2007 (3) RCR (Criminal) 1052, the prayer made in the petition is allowed, proceedings by way of FIR No.143 dated 10.05.2014 under Section 498-A IPC pertaining to Police Station A Division, Amritsar City (Annexure P1) and all consequences arising out of the said FIR qua the petitioners are quashed.

The petition stands allowed in those terms.
