Prayer in this petition is for grant of regular bail in FIR No.40 dated 02.07.2019 under Sections 21/29 of NDPS Act, registered at Police Station Kacha Pakka, District Tarn Taran.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that as per allegations in the FIR, the police party stopped a motorcycle, whose registration number plate was missing, upon which three boys were riding. Two persons were caught at the spot, whose names are Jaswinder Singh @ Harpreet Singh @ Happy and Subhampreet Singh @ Shub and third person, who ran away from the spot, was Gurjant Singh @ Janta. It is further submitted that from two persons, 310 grams of heroin was recovered and thereafter, on the basis of disclosure statement of co-accused, name of the petitioner surfaced. Learned counsel further submits that the petitioner is in custody since 01.09.2019; he is not involved in any other

case and challan stands presented.

Learned State counsel, on instructions from HC Rajpal, has not disputed the factual position.

Without commenting anything on merits of the case, considering the aforesaid submissions made by learned counsel for the parties, this petition is allowed and the petitioner is directed to be released on regular bail subject to furnishing his bail/surety bonds to the satisfaction of the trial Court/Illaq Magistrate/Duty Magistrate, concerned.

Petition is disposed of.
