The petitioner was convicted in a criminal complaint filed under Section 138 of the Negotiable Instruments Act, 1881, sentenced to undergo simple imprisonment for a period of six months and to pay compensation to the tune of ₹28,50,000/-.

The present revision petition is pending for the last one year. The petitioner was not granted the benefit of suspension of sentence. By now, the petitioner must have completed his sentence.

Learned counsel for the petitioner was not present on 26.03.2019. Position is not different today. Respondent, in spite of service, is also not present.

It appears that the petitioner is not interested in prosecuting the present revision petition.

Dismissed for non-prosecution.
