By way of filing this petition, the petitioners seek quashing of FIR No.340 dated 25.10.2017 registered at Police Station Nissing, District Karnal under Sections 323, 324, 148, 149, 506 and 307 of Indian Penal Code and Section 25 of Arms Act and all consequential proceedings emanating therefrom on the basis of a compromise having been effected between the parties.

Vide order dated 23.7.2018, the parties had been directed to appear before the Illaqa Magistrate/trial Court so as to get their statements recorded qua the factum of compromise.

Report of learned Additional District & Sessions Judge, Karnal has been received, wherein it has been reported that the statements of 10 petitioners/accused as well as of 8 injured including the complainant Sheo Singh have been recorded to the effect that they have compromised the matter amongst themselves with the intervention of respectables in order to

maintain peace in the village by ignoring all the past differences between them. The injured have specifically stated that they have no objection in case the FIR in question is quashed.

It has specifically been opined by learned Additional District & Sessions Judge, Karnal that the parties have entered into compromise amicably out of their free WILL without there being any pressure, coercion or undue influence.

In view of the aforesaid compromise and bearing in mind the law laid down by Full Bench of this Court in 2007(3) RCR (Crl.) 1052 Kulwinder Singh and others Vs. State of Punjab, the present petition is allowed and FIR No.340 dated 25.10.2017 registered at Police Station Nissing, District Karnal under Sections 323, 324, 148, 149, 506 and 307 of Indian Penal Code and Section 25 of Arms Act and all the consequent proceedings arising therefrom are hereby quashed qua the petitioners.
